ROSEVILLE POLICE SEEK THE PUBLICS HELP IN DRIVE-BY SHOOTING

The Roseville Police Department is seeking the public's help identifying a vehicle and its occupants involved in a drive-by shooting that occurred on Monday, June 20, 2016 resulting in an innocent bystander being wounded by gunfire.

At approximately 7:39 p.m., Roseville Police were is dispatched to the 200 block of Grandview Avenue on a report of multiple gun shots, a vehicle that had crashed into a parked car and gunshot victim losing consciousness in a nearby apartment complex parking lot.

According to witnesses, a dark colored sport utility vehicle was traveling east on Grandview Avenue towards Rice Street when the vehicle's front seat passenger leaned out an open window and began firing a handgun at a vehicle exiting the Hillsborough Apartment complex.

Witnesses state approximately 6-7 gunshots were fired from the suspect vehicle. Police believe one of the rounds may have ricocheted off the pavement with a bullet fragment striking a 50-year old innocent bystander who happened to be walking to his car parked in the complex parking lot.

The vehicle the suspect appeared to have targeted, struck a legally parked car as it accelerated out of the parking lot.

The only injuries reported were to the innocent bystander struck by a bullet fragment. This person was transported by ambulance to a hospital with non-life threatening injuries and later released.

This is an active police investigation with agency investigators following up on all leads and processing physical evidence recovered at the scene.
