Dear Roseville Property Owner/Manager:

The City of Roseville has been exploring ways to maintain the prosperity and property values of our business community. To help achieve these goals, the City has instituted the Business Property Enhancement Program that is funded by the Roseville's Economic Development Authority.

About the Business Property Enhancement Program

- The Business Property Enhancement Program began in 2013. This program has been well received by business owners and managers.
- The purpose is to raise awareness of the importance of keeping business properties in good repair and to help identify problems before they become more costly to fix.
- Roseville Code Enforcement staff visits approximately one-third of all business, commercial, residential and public properties each year. Properties are viewed from parking lots and sidewalks only to identify exterior maintenance or nuisance conditions. Staff will then work with property owners to remedy any issues.
