**Future Schedule**

If there are 28 YES votes or more the road closure will go to the City Council for consideration on August 22. The public is welcome to attend this meeting. If there are less than 28 YES votes the project will be considered voided and County Road D will be reconstructed with Wheeler open and the temporary barriers will be removed.

If the Council approves the project on August 22, staff will present a feasibility report to the Public Works Environment and Transportation (PWETC) Commission on August 23 for recommendation.

If the PWETC recommends approval, the Council will consider adopting the feasibility report and setting the public hearing at the September 12 Council meeting for October 10.

If Council adopts the feasibility report, residents will receive notice of the improvement hearing with the proposed assessment amount for October 10. A public hearing will be held. Council will consider ordering the improvement.

If the improvements are ordered staff will advertise the project for bid. Council will then consider the bids and either award the bid for construction or reject bids.

If the project is authorized, the work will be completed. A final assessment hearing would be held in the Fall of 2017. Residents would receive a final assessment notice. If the assessments are adopted, any unpaid assessments would show up on 2018 taxes.
