Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in a variety of entry-level civil engineering work related to survey, design, construction & maintenance of the City’s infrastructure.
- Assist Engineering staff in measuring material quantities for engineering projects; estimating, measuring, inspecting, documenting construction activities; and truck counts for hauling operations.
- Assist survey crew to perform preliminary and construction surveys.
- Assist Public Works staff in field & office work including watermain and manhole structure inspections.
- Assist with traffic counts.
- Assist with field & office work related to underground utility locating (Gopher State One Call).
- Provide customer service to the public and contractors. Assist technical staff in providing information to the public and contractors.
- Data management: Maintain and update paper and electronic files. Assist with or create summaries and reports upon request.

- Students at an accredited university or technical school majoring in Civil Engineering or Civil Engineering Technology.
