Program has been modified:

-One instructor will work with a safely-distanced grouping of four **parent/child pairs** in separated “play zones,” with a total of eight pairs and two instructors in the program. The play areas will be separated between the two groupings, they will be clearly marked, and they will allow ample space for parent/child pairs to engage in the activities.

Arrival and Departure Information:

- SOAS parents should **park in the Lexington Park parking lot** on County Road B.
- Standing spots with signage will be set up 6’ apart on the sidewalk leading from the Lexington Park parking lot to the check-in table for SOAS. Participants will be instructed to stand in line on a spot, advancing when those in front move up a spot.
- A check-in table will be placed at the edge of the SOAS program area, in proximity to the sidewalk, with a standing spot marked 6’ away. The Program Coordinator will check in participants, answer questions, etc., have them use hand sanitizer, and then direct parent/child pairs to their “play zone.” Parents will be asked each day if they have checked themselves and their child for listed/displayed Covid-19 symptoms.

Spectator Information:

- Boundaries for any spectators will be set up with at least 6’ distance.

Basic Cleaning Information:

- The sports equipment and other items used for each activity will be cleaned/disinfected before and between each program by SOAS staff.
