The following class time procedures will be followed.

- Each child will have their own set of supplies.
- Supplies will be disinfected at the end of the class.
- Require Abrakadoodle instructors to wear masks while indoors.
- Children will have assigned seats to ensure social distancing.
- Small class sizes to ensure social distancing.
- Maintain social distancing at all times.

Arrival and Departure Information:

We are allowing one family in the lobby area of the park building at a time for check-in or check out. We will ask parents and participants to wait outside until it's their turn to enter for check-in. We ask that you please do not bring siblings that are not attending the camp into the classroom area during drop-off or pick-up.

Spectator Information:

In order to keep a controlled and safe environment during the class as well as the amount of space in the room, we will not be allowing spectators at the program.

Basic Cleaning Information:

Disinfecting Protocol

The following disinfecting procedures will be followed.

- Increase the frequency of handwashing during class.
- Disinfecting all hard surfaces after each class.
- Disinfecting areas that are commonly touched such as door handles, cabinet handles, sink handles, toilet handles, light switches, soap and towel dispensers after each class.
