ISI to Learn to Skate USA

- 1) How do I obtain my Learn to Skate USA Membership?
 - a. Follow the link provided on the Roseville Skate School website to purchase your annual Learn to Skate membership. Each skater will need a current Learn to Skate Membership prior to registering for their class. Registration Learn to Skate USA
- 2) Why do I need to obtain a Learn to Skate USA Membership?
 - a. The Roseville Skate School is now part of the Learn to Skate USA program. This program offers many benefits which include:
 - i. Instruction from background screened, certified instructors
 - ii. Instruction that follows a standardized curriculum
 - iii. A welcome packet includes a parent handbook and record book to keep track of your progress in class
 - iv. Access to online educational materials
 - v. Access to Learn to Skate USA mobile app
 - vi. Secondary sports accident insurance
- 3) How will the previous ISI levels translate to the new Learn to Skate USA levels?
 - a. Skaters in basic skills classes should continue to register for their correct age group for group lessons. Once in the group for their age group, skaters will be placed into their appropriate level.
 - Skaters in freestyle levels should continue to register for their freestyle level class (the ISI and Learn to Skate levels will be listed on registration for ease of understanding for the next 3 sessions).
 - c. If you have any additional questions about the conversion levels from ISI to Learn to Skate USA, please contact the Skate Director (651) 792-7131.
- 4) Will ice show requirements for soloists and features stay the same?
 - a. Yes, ice show requirements will stay the same for those currently in the ISI program going forward. We will enhance the requirements going forward to include Learn to Skate USA components as well, but will grandfather those in who are already in the ISI program.
- 5) Can I continue to take ISI tests if I want to continue on that track?
 - a. Any skater can continue to keep their ISI membership valid and continue testing as they desire. We will maintain some ISI judges on our staff and look to hold ISI test sessions intermittently going forward as needed.
