

Opt-In Recycling: Small Businesses and Churches

What is Opt-In?

Churches and small business have the opportunity to recycle by using this service. By signing up and paying for Eureka Recycling to pick up recycling from each organization ("opting in"), one or two 95 gallon carts will pick up recycling every other week. Churches and small businesses are encouraged to use this service because their volume of recycling often matches the capacity of one or two carts.

The City of Roseville's Comprehensive Plan 2040 "strives to increase environmental outreach and education in order to protect the environment" (Chapter 9). The Opt-In program is one way to increase the success of environmental protection in Roseville.

Why Should Businesses and Churches Get Involved?

- Recycling diverts waste from landfills, conserves a large amount of energy, and limits the natural resources needed to create new products by repurposing used materials.
- At this time in Ramsey County, for every \$100 of garbage, \$70 is paid in tax (70% tax). Recycling is not taxed. If large amounts of garbage are diverted from the waste bin to recycling, money can be saved.
