

Sprouts 2020 Fall Safety Sheet



PROGRAM NAME: Sprouts: Fall Series

The following safety sheet has been created to share important information to keep participants and instructors safe. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Program Supervisor:

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Program has been modified:

Sprouts programs will occur upstairs at HANC, with curtain divider between activity stations and the sharing circle. The upstairs classroom will be used for art and other messy activities. The nature center will be closed to public visitors both mornings of the monthly program until noon.

- Group sharing circle will be set up with carpet circles spaced at least 6' apart, and each carpet circle will have an individual basket with items for each parent/child pair.
- Activity, art & snack stations will be placed at the ends of 6' tables, with tables spaced at least 6' apart.
- When possible, multi-touch items, like paint brushes and sensory tub items, will be separated with "Clean" and "Used" containers.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and its use encouraged at start of program and between activity stations
- One parent/child pair at a time will be allowed at each activity station, with 5-min rotations.
- Snack items will be individually packaged and pre- placed on paper plates for each child.

Arrival and Departure Information:

- Check-in will be at a table in front of HANC entry doors (with 6' spots marked up to the outer doors and onto the pavement beyond).
- Checked-in pairs will be directed to place their coats, bags, etc., in the coat hall and then sit at a carpet circle to examine individual sharing baskets.
- Departure is on an individual basis.

Spectator Information:

Not applicable.

Basic Cleaning Information:

- Furniture and fixtures will be wiped with spray disinfectant.
- Activity station & sharing basket items - some washed w/soap & water and disinfected; some (puzzles, books, etc.) wiped with disinfectant wipes.
- Stuffed animals will be replaced with clean versions between 2-day programs and laundered after each monthly program.

Facial Covering Information:

Instructors **AND** participants (parents and children 2+ years) are encouraged to wear masks during the indoor part of the program.

Instructors will be required to wear a mask when checking-in/checking-out participants, while performing any form of first-aid, during cleaning and disinfecting procedures, and during any program held indoors. If staff are not performing these activities, and/or if the activity is being held outdoors, staff will not be required to wear a mask.

PLEASE NOTE: It is important to note that all Roseville Parks and Recreation programs have been planned, developed and conducted following the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and MDH guidelines for Social Distancing in Recreational Programs. Please be aware there is some risk of participating in any activity during the pandemic. Even though we are working to provide as safe as an environment as possible, 100% mitigation cannot be guaranteed for any activity.
