

STEM Club 2020 Fall Safety Sheet



The following safety sheet has been created to share important information to keep participants and instructors safe. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Program Supervisor:

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Program Modifications:

- Activities will take place in the HANC lower level classroom at 6' tables with one participant stationed at each end (opposite sides) and tables spaced at least 6' apart.
- Each participant will be provided small sets of (sanitized) hands-on items or individual building materials when possible.
- For necessary shared items, a supply station will be set up at least 6' apart from individual tables, where participants can take turns getting supplies and taking them back to their stations.
- Paper items will be organized into individual packets for each participant and placed at each table station before each program session.

Arrival and Departure Information:

- Standing spots with signage will be set up 6' apart on pavement by HANC front doors (which will be locked).
- Campers & parents will be instructed to stand in line on a spot, advancing down the steps when those in front move up a spot.
- The instructor will greet participants at the concrete slab by back door and will instruct parents to leave via the lower path.
- The instructor will verify that participants have been checked for Covid symptoms (including temperature taking) on the day of the program, and that they are wearing a mask before entering the classroom.

- Participants will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the room and then be seated at their table station.
- Participants will be given a short activity to keep them occupied until the start of the program.
- For pick-up, each parent will wait (at least 6' apart) outside the classroom door and will give their child's name to the instructor. Participants will be called one at a time to join their parent and will be directed to leave via lower path.

Basic Cleaning Information:

- Daily building & bathroom cleaning and disinfecting by Roseville Parks & Recreation staff.
- All high-touch surfaces (counters, ,chairs, door handles, chairs, program supplies, tools & implements) disinfected by program staff as needed between activities and after each day's program.

Facial Covering Information:

- Instructors and participants are required to wear masks during the entire program.
