PROGRAM NAME: **Family Egg Dyeing Egg-stravaganza (at HANC)**

PROGRAM HAS BEEN MODIFIED:

Program will be set up in HANC lower level. One table per family will be arranged at least 6' apart for nature lesson and independent activities. Shared activity stations will be spaced at least 6' apart with hand sanitizer provided at each station. Egg dyeing will be set up on kitchen counters, colors 6' apart, and distancing monitored during dyeing. Participants will be asked to maintain social distancing while out on boardwalk.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFORMATION:

Participants will be greeted at the downstairs door (signage on upper level front door), checked for mask wearing and asked to use hand sanitizer before sitting at separate tables. Children will be accompanied by an adult, so they will leave together when finished.

BASIC CLEANING INFORMATION:

-All downstairs high touch surfaces (counters, table tops, chairs, door handles, chairs, program supplies)
Sanitize all

-Downstairs bathroom cleaning & disinfecting

FACIAL COVERING INFORMATION:

Instructors AND participants are required to wear masks during the indoor part of the program. If the activity is being held outdoors, neither will be required to wear a mask.
