ORDINANCE NO. 1607

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, SECTION 309 MASSAGE THERAPY

The City Council of the City of Roseville does ordain:

SECTION 1: Title 3, Section 309.03 (D), (F) and (G), Granting, Denying or Revoking of Massage Therapy Establishment Licenses of the Roseville City Code is amended to read as follows:

- D. <u>History of Violations Compliance with Laws</u>: Licenses may be denied, <u>revoked</u>, or <u>rescinded not renewed</u> if the applicant, licensee, or employee, <u>contractor</u>, <u>or agent</u> of the same fails to comply with, <u>or have a history of violations of the laws or ordinances federal</u>, <u>state</u>, <u>or local laws</u> which apply to health, safety or moral turpitude.
- F. Unlicensed Operators: No Massage Therapy Establishments may permit any person to conduct massage therapy on the licensed premises who is not fully licensed under this Chapter as a Massage Therapist.
- G. Total Licenses: After November 9, 2021, no new Massage Therapy Establishment licenses shall be issued and no Massage Therapy Establishment licenses shall be reinstated following denial, revocation, or non-renewal unless fewer than twenty-five (25) total Massage Therapy Establishment licenses exist in the City. Thereafter, the total Massage Therapy Establishment licenses in the City shall not exceed twenty-five (25) at any one time.

SECTION 2: Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
