RE: South McCarron's Retaining Wall Project - Neighborhood Meeting Notice

Dear Resident:

As many of you are aware, the City is starting the design process to replace the large retaining wall on the south side of South McCarron's Boulevard between Woodruff Avenue and Glenwood Street due to the condition of the existing retaining wall. The existing wall is **not** in immediate danger of failure, but is showing signs it will need to be replaced in the next few years. City staff is monitoring the wall for any indication that the wall is getting worse.

Place: Intersection of South McCarrons Blvd. & Glenwood St.
